### Note TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Rate confirmation must be signed on all pages and emailed back to your broker
- Should a problem or change arise at any time, notify Express Freight Broker(s) immediately 24/7. E-mail your broker.
- The rate is for exclusive truck only unless stated in writing.
- Carrier must check, report and inform if any apparent cargo damage exists prior loading and must note damages in the bill of lading at the time
  of loading and/or unloading before leaving the facility. Do not sign for damaged goods. Notify Express Freight Broker(s) immediately 24/7.
- Express Freight Broker is not responsible for overweight/gross trailers after the driver has left the shipper's facility.
- It is the carrier's responsibility to confirm or make any necessary appointments 24 hours in advance & confirm the delivery address on bills. If different, call and notify Express Freight Broker(s) immediately for approval 24/7, E-mail your broker.
- Any approved changes or charges must be noted on a new rate confirmation provided by Express Freight Broker.
- Express Freight Broker does not advance funds for any reason.
- Driver assists and fuel surcharges are included in the rate.
- The carrier verifies that there are no exclusions in their insurance policy that would apply to the freight being transported.
- Express Freight Brokers through a new rate confirmation must pre-approve all lumpers and/or accessorial fees and an original receipt sent in with the carrier's invoice in order to be reimbursed.
- Carrier shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations, as well as all E.L.D. (Electronic Log Device) compliance regulations, concerning the transactions contemplated by this agreement.
- Carrier certifies that the transport equipment furnished for loading this shipment is in compliance with applicable regulations. Furthermore, your driver's signature on the bill of lading is an acknowledgement of the above statement and certification that the equipment supplied by said company for loading is in compliance.
- All "Drop Trailer" loads require the carrier to drop a trailer at the origin 24hrs prior to the pick-up time and provide a parking slip number to the broker unless otherwise instructed during load booking. Failure to do so may result in misload, delayed loading or load rejection for which broker will not be held responsible financially.
- Carrier is responsible for providing a trailer that is in a "Good" condition. Bald tires, flat tires, failed mechanical parts, flooring, door hinges, door locks, lighting, wiring, connectors etc. may result in a misload for which the broker will not be held responsible financially.
- If a load is cancelled or rejected for whatever reason, upon notification it is the carrier's responsibility to remove the trailer from the origin in a timely manner to avoid being charged by the shipper or having trailer removed from the yard.
- The carrier should arrive at the origin 30 minutes prior to the agreed pick-up time and check in at the facility to avoid delayed departure time, misload and/or detention.
- A detention of up to \$600 may be charged by the broker for delayed pick-up or delivery based on the count of hours late. unless otherwise agreed during load booking.
- All team loads must have 2 drivers present with valid driver licenses at the origin and delivery, failure to follow these steps may result in load rejection and misload.
- If for any reason carrier is not able to deliver the load on time after the pick-up has been made, recovery options may be arranged upon
  request to deliver the carrier's loaded trailer to the destination. Rates would be recalculated based on travelled miles from the origin.

- 1. Please remain in your truck until you receive text then bring truck to scales (make sure you are completely on scales) then exit truck and go back to the window to receive clipboard with directions to dock.
- 2. After unloading if your truck needs swept out brooms are provided at the dock which you can remain at the dock and sweep your trailer out. Real Alloy employees do not sweep out trailers.
- 3. When you are finished LOADING/UNLOADING pull onto scales to check out and bring clipboard and/or bucket to window with clipboard and give to clerk. Clerk will sign and return delivery/pickup paperwork.
