When you or the carrier provide the driver's cell phone number, a text message will be sent to the driver with the Load Track request, including a link to download the Trucker Tools App. If the driver doesn't have the Trucker Tools App installed, the driver must download and install the FREE Trucker Tools App.

When the driver is assigned the load, they need to open the Trucker Tools App on iPhone or Android phone. Then, click the Load Track button on the main menu, and start the corresponding Load Track by clicking the Start Track button.

Carriers contracted to transport commodities covered or listed in the FDA's Final Rule of the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) are required to adhere to the following terms and conditions.

Carrier requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Carrier is responsible to comply with all applicable regulations and requirements of the FDA FSMA Final Rule, on Sanitary Transportation of Human and Animal Food issued May 27, 2016.
- Carrier, when operating in California, must meet the requirements of California Air Resources Board (CARB) amendments to the Transport Refrigeration Unit (TRU) Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) effective January 1 2013. Carrier acknowledges that it meets these regulations for the specific trailer refrigeration unit utilized to transport Matson Logistics shipments while on California roadways and highways. Carriers must register all such refrigeration units on: https://arber.arb.ca.gov/publicTruSearch.arb
- Carrier, when not operating in California, may disregard the above paragraph but must agree to comply with the remaining Temperature control requirements as set forth is this contract
- Carrier agrees to indemnify, protect and hold Matson Logistics harmless for any all fines, penalties and expenses Matson Logistics may incur as a result of Carrier not being CARB and or FSMA compliant.
- Carrier and drivers are responsible to strictly adhere to all written guidelines and instructions provided by Matson Logistics and the Shipper
- Trailer must be clean and empty and in a food grade status at shipment appointment time. Carrier must clean the trailer when necessary to achieve such food grade status and agrees to be wholly responsible for sanitary conditions during transport.
- Carrier must provide an adequate supply of fuel and lubricants required for the intended normal operation of the unit(s) prior to appointment.
- Trailer must be pre-cooled to the appropriate level if the Matson Logistics dispatch indicates a frozen or refrigerated commodity is to be picked up.
- Carrier shall maintain motor truck cargo liability insurance that includes coverage for mechanical breakdown
 or failure of refrigeration or heating units installed in or on Carrier's vehicles. Carrier's certificate of
 insurance must specifically state that the motor truck cargo liability policy includes such coverage, with the
 deductible shown.
- Carrier must notify a Matson Logistics dispatcher immediately if the mechanical refrigeration unit becomes
 inoperable due to any reason and puts the commodity at risk and to allow Matson Logistics to assess the
 situation prior to contacting the customer.
- Carrier shall maintain all refrigeration and heating units in good condition. Such units shall be inspected by
 Carrier or a service company in accordance with the recommendations of the manufacturers or at least once
 every 30 days, whichever is more often. Carrier shall make any repairs and perform all corrective or
 preventive maintenance as specified by the manufacturer of the units. Carrier shall maintain records of such
 inspections, repairs and maintenance.
- In the event of loss, Carrier shall, as soon as commercially reasonable, provide Matson Logistics with all records of inspections that relate to the loss and permit copies and abstracts to be made from them.

1.0 Purpose

For the purpose of this document, Constantia Blythewood, LLC and Constantia Colmar, LLC will be furthermore known as Constantia.

To assure the quality and safety of all shipments, Constantia requires that all carriers be inspected to verify that padlocks and/or seals are present, intact, of the appropriate type, and have numbers that match the shipping documents.

2.0 Scope

This policy applies to all carriers responsible for deliveries to Customers or from Suppliers for Constantia.

3.0 Procedure

- 3.1 All LTL shipments will use a padlock which must be installed by the driver and checked visually by the Constantia shipping department prior to trailer leaving premises. A padlock must remain on the trailer until the receiving department at the customer instructs the driver to remove the padlock and approves delivery.
- 3.2 All full trailer loads must be sealed, with the correct seal number on the shipping document. Seals shall be properly applied, and the corresponding seal numbers recorded on shipping documents. Properly applied includes choosing a location opposite from the hinges for the opening. If multiple covers or hatches are used in sequence for the same opening, the outer one (at a minimum) should be the one to seal. Seals should be attached tightly, so the door or hatch can't be opened more than 1/8 inch. The seal must remain intact until the receiving department at the customer verifies the seal information and approves delivery.
- 3.3 All full trailer loads going to a Customer that has more than one delivery point must be sealed, with the correct seal number on the shipping document. The seal must remain intact until the receiving department at the first Customer plant verifies the seal information and approves delivery. After delivery to the first Customer plant, a padlock must be used on the trailer for the remaining Customer deliveries until the receiving department at each Customer plant instructs the driver to remove the padlock and approves delivery. The driver must keep the original seal with them to show at subsequent Customer plants should their receiving department request verification.

4.0 Responsibility

- 4.1 Padlocks It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure padlocks are used at all times and are not removed until instructed to do so by the receiving department at the customer. It is the responsibility of the shipping department of Constantia to ensure the padlock is in place prior to the truck leaving Constantia's premises.
- 4.2 Seals It is the responsibility of the shipping department of Constantia to ensure seals are placed on trailers with full loads and the correct seal number is on the shipping document(s). It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure the seal remains intact on the trailer until instructed to be removed by the receiving department of the customer.
- 4.3 It is the responsibility of the carrier to use trained drivers who understand and can comply with Constantia's Transportation Procedures as outlined in this policy.
- 4.4 It is the responsibility of the carrier to ensure all shipments are delivered per Constantia's transportation policies as contained herein. Any fines/penalties assessed to Constantia for rejected loads directly caused by non-compliance to the procedures contained herein will be the responsibility of the carrier.
- 4.5 It is the responsibility of the carrier to ensure that trailers used for transporting product from Constantia are free of holes, glass, odor, and dirt and exterior is free of noticeable foreign objects.
- 4.6 It is the responsibility of the carrier to ensure hazardous waste, toxic gases, poisons, noxious items and non food grade items are not transported with any products from Constantia.
- 4.7 It is the responsibility of Constantia to verify and sign off on the condition of inbound and outbound trailers per requirements listed above.
- 4.8 It is the responsibility of the carrier to ensure all drivers employed or contracted by the carrier are properly trained on the Transportation Procedures contained herein and will provide training records upon request.

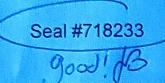
