TQL must approve all accessorial terms/charges in advance and in writing. Payment of detention is determined on a load-by-load basis. Unauthorized charges will not be paid. Detention payment does not begin for at least 3 hours unless otherwise agreed to in writing. To qualify for additional compensation, the Carrier MUST notify TQL at least 30 minutes before beginning detention time and when arriving-on-time/departing from all shippers/receivers (unless the shipper/receiver will notate check in/out times on the paperwork).



THIS IS AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN TQL AND CARRIER. CARRIER SHALL HAUL THE LOAD AT THE RATE ABOVE. CARRIER SHALL CALL TQL FOR LOAD INFORMATION. RESPONDING TO OR READING A TQL SMS MESSAGE WHILE DRIVING A TRUCK OR MOTOR VEHICLE CAN CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE TO YOU OR OTHERS. DO NOT READ OR REPLY TO A MESSAGE UNLESS YOUR VEHICLE IS STATIONARY AND PARKED. THE CARRIER, DRIVER, AND ANY OTHER EMPLOYEE AND/OR AGENT FOR CARRIER ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ABIDING BY THESE INSTRUCTIONS AND AGREE THAT THEY WILL COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: RECEIVING, READING AND/OR SENDING SMS MESSAGES, PHONE CALLS, AND/OR ANY OTHER INFORMATION TO OR FROM THE BROKER. CARRIER AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD TQL HARMLESS TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW FOR ANY AND ALL CLAIMS OF ANY NATURE ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THE HAULING OF THIS LOAD, THE VIOLATION OF THE TERMS OF THE BROKER-CARRIER AGREEMENT OR THIS RATE CONFIRMATION.

Carrier Requirements

- Driver is required to accept and maintain Carrier Dashboard or MacroPoint tracking for the entirety of transit.
- Tracking is mandatory for the shipment. If tracking is not turned on deductions from final invoice may be applied.
- Exclusive use of the trailer is required, and the load cannot be run as a partial.





- All deliveries require original paperwork including the BOL, packing list, hazmat paperwork, customs documents, or any other shipping document provided at pick up.
- Driver must be able to provide their Driver Certificate of Training document if requested while at a GM facility.
- Any delays in delivery must be communicated to TQL immediately.
- Re-brokering of shipments is not permitted, and carrier must use their own trucks and drivers that are fully covered by their own insurance.
- No repairs to the tractor or trailer should be conducted on GM property.
- No weapons or other dangerous devices are permitted on GM property. This includes the secured perimeter and the commercial traffic yard.
- No children, non-driving passengers or pets are permitted on GM property.
- Detention is forfeited if the driver is late for pickup or delivery time.
- If commodity is batteries: Driver must take pictures of loaded product and send them via email to <u>teamrawson@tql.com</u>. Must also verify load is secured properly so it cannot shift in transit

For all MO-TN loads:

Carrier cannot layover in Memphis or at receiver

Accessorials

- TONU \$150. Non-negotiable
- Layover \$150. Non-negotiable
- Detention \$15 per 30 minutes
- Trailer detention in the event drop trailer takes longer than anticipated \$25 per day

Trailer Requirements

- Trailer must be 53' long.
- Trailer must be less than 10 years old.
- Driver must complete a pre and post trip inspection of trailer
- Trailer must have a DOT inspection within the last year.
- Current, legible, unexpired DOT inspection sticker and MGG plate must be present.
- Trailer must be clean, in sound physical condition, odor free, dry, leak proof, and free of contamination/infestation.
- Trailer will not be loaded if it appears to be damaged.
- Trailer floors must have a 20,000 pound dynamic floor rating or greater.
- Trailer tandems must be put in the rear-most position and the locking pin set prior to dropping the trailer. If the tandems are not slid back and locked, the trailer will be refused.
- Trailer must be identified from the front and rear using the SCAC, including rentals.

Seal Requirements

- Trailer must be sealed prior to leaving the shipper.
- For all shipments carrying GM product, at each cargo entry point, driver must verify the shipper affixed a seal imprinted with a unique seal number on all rail carload, truckload and intermodal shipments.
 - If the shipper does not provide the seal, the driver must apply the seal, report the seal number on the shipping documentation, and report the incident to TQL immediately.
- Seal number must be recorded on the shipping documentation.
- If the seal is removed in transit (even by government officials), a second seal must be placed on the trailer by the driver, the new seal number must be noted on the paperwork, and TQL must be notified immediately.
- Driver must follow the VVTT seal method (View, Verify, Twist, and Tug) prior to departing the shipper and at each stop.
- At delivery, if the security officer or material department representative deem the seal to be valid, the driver must remove the seal and discard into the approved used seal bin at the security gate.
- Tab seals or plastic truck seals must only be used when the origin/final destination are within the U.S.
- High security cable seals must be used for shipments going to the U.S., Canada, Mexico, and U.S. to U.S. transiting through Canada.
- Cable seal must be used for cross border shipments to the U.S., Canada or Mexico, and must be compliant with ISO 17712:2013 testing standard.
 - Seal must be wrapped around both the trailer door mechanisms, between the left and right inboard locking rods, at the





point where the door handle is attached.

- Bolt seal must be used for ISO containers, rail, and truck/trailer doors.
 - If a bolt seal is being used for shipments into the U.S., Canada, or Mexico, the seal must be compliance with ISO 17712:2013 testing standards.

Pick Up Instructions

- Upon arrival at the dock, the driver must time stamp the BOLs and present them to the dock personnel and request a back-in door.
- Rear doors of the trailer are only to be opened when the trailer is square to, on in a position to be backed into the receiving dock door.
- When backing into a dock, sound horn and use four-way flashers. The bogies must be in the rear position of the trailer with axle locking pin in place.
- When backed into the door, turn off engine and set air brakes (diesel fumes cannot enter the plant).
- Driver must place 2 wheel chocks in front of the rear wheels, on either side or one on each side and in all cases, placed against the wheel whether in power or not.
- Truck may not be left idling. Tractor engines must be shut off when:
 - The trailer has been engaged to a receiving dock
 - The trailer is waiting for a receiving dock
 - If for some reason the driver finds it necessary to park the trailer at any GM location
 - If this policy is not followed, you will not be permitted to haul loads to this facility again and you may be subject to a fine of \$1,000.
- Driver is not permitted to pull the trailer from a dock until the dock personnel communicate that the trailer is ready to be removed and the green light outside the dock is on.
- Driver must ensure the dock plate is up and the ICC bar is released prior to pulling the trailer out.
- Driver must remove the wheel chocks and jack stands from under the trailer and place them in a safe area.
- Driver is responsible for ensuring the shipment is properly loaded, blocked, braced, secured and tarped when applicable.

Driver PPE

- Driver must wear an approved face mask at all GM facilities. Approved masks are N95 and medical masks. Masks that are homemade or have exhalation valves are not permitted.
- Driver must have proper footwear that provides adequate protection. No open-toed, open-sided/heel, high heels, sandals, or flipflops are permitted.
- Driver must wear safety glasses with side shields at all times within any GM Processing Centers or GM Parts Distribution Centers.
- · Driver must wear completely enclosed, hard-soled, substantial shoes or boots at all times within any GM facility.

Drop Trailer Loads

- Dropped trailers should only have the required safety seal and should have any additional locks.
- On drop loads, jack-stands are required at the front corners of the trailer as well as the approximate middle on both sides of the trailer.
- All jack-stands should be places within 2 inches of the bottom of the trailer, but not directly underneath large design cutouts in the floor plating nor between floor cross-members
- All drop loads require that the wheel chocks be repositioned correctly after the tractor is released from the trailer.

Mexico/Canada Loads

- Your company must comply with all of the recommendations and requirements of CTPAT (Customs Trade Partnership Against Terrorism) and PIP (Partners in Protection).
- For shipments picking up in Canada or Mexico and delivering to the U.S., your company must be approved/validated for FAST (Free and Secure Trade Program).
- For long haul Mexico shipments and Mexico transfer/drayage shipments, your company must be approved/validated for FAST.
- For shipments delivering to Canada, your company must be approved/validated for FAST.
