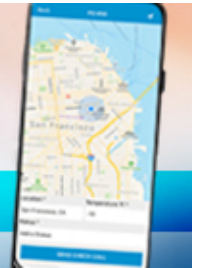
TRANSFLO Express allows you to scan and send invoices

TQL must approve all accessorial terms/charges in advance and in writing. Payment of detention is determined on a load-by-load basis. Unauthorized charges will not be paid. Detention payment does not begin for at least 3 hours unless otherwise agreed to in writing. To qualify for additional compensation, the Carrier MUST notify TQL at least 30 minutes before beginning detention time and when arriving-on-time/departing from all shippers/receivers (unless the shipper/receiver will notate check in/out times on the paperwork).

IF LOAD IS CHANGED OR CANCELED BY TQL, NO "TRUCK ORDER NOT USED" WILL BE PAID UNLESS TQL HAS PROVIDED THE CARRIER WITH LOAD DETAILS (PICK-UP NUMBER, SHIPPER NAME/ADDRESS AND DRIVER INFORMATION SHEET) AND APPROVED THE CARRIER TO BEGIN DRIVING TOWARDS THE PICK-UP LOCATION. Carrier requirements:

- Driver must accept and maintain TQL's Carrier Dashboard/Macropoint/Project44 Tracking for the duration of the shipment.
- Exclusive use of the trailer is required, and the load cannot be run as a partial.
- Load cannot go to the driver's home or be left unattended.
- Driver(s) must arrive at the shipper with a full tank of fuel, well rested, and fresh on hours.
- Driver(s) must drive 250 miles after picking up.
- Trailer must be locked and sealed prior to leaving the shipper.
- Driver(s) must back up against a wall or pole to ensure the doors cannot be opened any time a stop is to be made, and one driver must maintain line of sight with the trailer doors at all times.
- Driver is responsible for counting product at shipper and must report any shortages/damages to broker before leaving shipper. Carrier accepts financial responsibility for shortage/damages not reported before leaving shipper.
- In the event of a breakdown or any delay that jeopardizes on-time delivery, TQL may require that the carrier allow a repower of their trailer to avoid/mitigate damages.
- Late delivery may result in non-payment of freight charges, and special damages as a consequence of being late may apply. This includes, but is not limited to, freight charges for expedited shipments, packaging materials, additional labor charges, storage charges, spoiled product, loss of sale, the expense of any additional equipment, service, or alternate transportation arrangements that need to be utilized as a result of late delivery.
- Additional charges must be requested with 2 hours of delivery, otherwise they are subject to non-payment.

Load requires the following communication:

- At the time driver is checked in to the facility
- At the time driver is loaded and rolling
- At the time driver is unloaded
- 30 minutes before detention time begins

Detention Policy and Accessorial Charges:

- GPS tracking must be accepted and maintained the entirety of transit in order to qualify for any detention, layover, or accessorial pay.
- BOL/POD must have times written and signed by the shipper/receiver in order for request to be reviewed.
- Late trucks may not be compensated for detention time or layover.
- Detention time starts 3 hours after the appointment time.
- Detention pay begins after 3 free hours and is paid at \$30.00 per hour
- Detention pays caps at layover rate of \$250.00.
- Layover of \$250 per day is applicable if wait time exceeds 10 hours, at the shipper or receiver.
- Truck Order Not Used will be paid only if trucker arrives at the shipper, or deadheads over 60 miles to shipper.
- By signing this Rate Confirmation, Carrier agrees to \$150 Truck Order Not Used Policy.
- If Carrier decides to leave due to wait time or other circumstances, the Truck Order Not Used Fee will be forfeited.
- Additional charges must be requested with 2 hours of delivery, otherwise they are subject to non-payment.

Proof of Delivery Policy:

- Broker will provide BOL to the carrier via email at the time of dispatching. Carrier is responsible for having the receiver sign this paperwork or \$500 late fee per day will apply.
- If correct BOL paperwork is not signed, the broker may request the carrier to go back to the shipper to retrieve signature, to meet the above requirement.
- Correct POD must be sent to broker within 24 hours of delivery to Teamfell@tql.com





