## **Special Instructions:**

1. DRIVER MUST VERIFY PU NUMBER and DEL NUMBER ON BOL MATCHES THE NUMBERS ON THE RATECON PRIOR TO LEAVING THE SHIPPER. ANY ISSUES AT DELIVERY AS A RESULT OF INCORRECT NUMBERS IS SOLELY THE LIABILITY OF THE CARRIER!

2. Driver is responsible for the integrity of the load. The load must be secured prior to leaving the shipper.

\*\*\*DETENTION POLICY\*\*\* - Appointments: Carrier must notify broker when they are checked in AND at the
60 minute mark. If the carrier notifies broker after the 60 minute mark, the detention time will start 60
minutes after contact by the carrier. Detention will be capped at \$250. DETENTION BECOMES NULL AND
VOID IF CARRIER IS MORE THAN 15 MINUTES LATE FOR APPT. FCFS Facilities: Detention is only paid at
FCFS facilities after 4 hours and is Capped at \$150/per day. Carrier must still notify broker when they are
checked in. If the carrier agrees to a load where there is an issue at the shipper/receiver (i.e. short staffed)
that may result in longer than usual wait times, Detention will start 60 minutes after the cutoff for the facility
at which they are picking up/delivering (i.e. Appointment - 3hrs, FCFS - 5hrs).

When emailing paperwork to be processed for payment, it MUST be emailed to accounting@intxlog.com or it will not be processed.

This Rate Confirmation is an agreement between Integrity Express Logistics LLC and the carrier indicated in the above Carrier Information field, and is NOT a dispatch. If load is changed or canceled by Integrity Express Logistics LLC, NO "truck order not used" will be paid unless the driver has been dispatched by the broker at Integrity Express Logistics LLC. Carriers are required to call Integrity Express Logistics for dispatch which includes pick up numbers, name, address and directions to the shipper.

### 1. GENERAL CARRIER REQUIREMENTS:

- i. CARRIER is responsible for any damage to product or damage to the products container and shortages of freight. CARRIER is responsible for any charges, or claims BROKER is charged pertaining to this shipment.
- ii. Driver is responsible for load and count. Must report product quantities stated on BOL's PRIOR to leaving the shipper. If Driver is not allowed on dock to verify product count, IEL must be notified PRIOR to driver signing for product and BOL's must be marked by Shipper "Shipper Load and Count"
- iii. Failure to report any overage, shortage, or damage (damage with pictures) within 2 hours will result in a \$125 fine to CARRIER.
- iv. Any costs incurred by BROKER due to CARRIER being late for pick-up or delivery appointments may be charged to the CARRIER.
- v. Carrier can be charged up to \$250 per day for late arrival to any appointment plus any additional loss due late arrival.
- vi. Drivers are required to check call every day, before 10am EST. Failure to do so can result in a \$125 fine.
- vii. Failure to call IMMEDIATELY on any problems can result in a \$100.00 fine to CARRIER as well as any charges that result from failure to notify BROKER. IEL is available 24/7/365.
- viii. If any accessorial charge is agreed upon, carrier must supply VALID receipt. Failure to do so within 48 hours of delivery can result in no reimbursement. Hand written receipt is NOT VALID.
- ix. Half Loaded/Incomplete loaded trailer can result in a reduced pro-rated payment.
- x. Driver must ensure load is properly secured. Any concerns or requests for additional securements must be made PRIOR to leaving shipper. Carrier will be liable for any damage.
- xi. Loads sealed by the shipper must remain sealed until an authorized person at the receiver breaks the seal. In cases where the seal has been broken by an unauthorized person, the CARRIER becomes FULLY liable for the invoice value to customer or cost whichever is greater, of the product and any other expenses.
- xii. \$35 will be deducted from your invoice for each comcheck issued for a fuel or cash advance.
- xiii. Integrity Express Logistics has the right to offset any claim/s or fee with pending invoices including but not limited to, property damage caused by Carrier at shipper or receiver.
- xiv. Carrier agrees that the driver has enough available hours of service to pick up and drop the tendered load within time frames arranged by Broker/Customer, without violating the FMCSA hours (49 CFR 395).
- xv. Carrier is in compliance with Federal, State and Local safety regulations.
- xvi. A fee of \$7.50 per pallet will be charged on loads that the carrier is responsible to supply pallets for exchange and they do not.
- xvii. All accessorial charges must be pre-approved by the broker. Unauthorized charges may not be paid.
- xviii. Not all detention request will be honored, the Broker must be notified 1 hour before Carrier is requesting detention.

#### 2. REFRIGERATED LOADS:

- i. All refrigerated load must be on CONTINUOUS cycle throughout the trip, unless instructed by the Broker. If reefer unit is not on CONTINUOUS, carrier assumes all risk of product.
- ii. Before loading, ensure reefer unit is properly working and pre-cool trailer to temperature indicated by Rate Con. or Broker.
- iii. Produce loads must have a properly working air chute for proper circulation. The driver is responsible to make sure the chute is not damaged, obstructed or blocked in any way. Driver is responsible to make sure space is provided for circulation.
- iv. Pulp product to ensure product has been pre-cooled. Do not accept any product pulping 3 or more degrees above or below the required temperature stated on rate confirmation. If the temperature on rate confirmation is different than what is on Bill of Lading, notify BROKER immediately before signing the Bill of Lading. By signing the Bill of Lading, CARRIER is responsible for product. Make sure the pulp temperature of the product loaded is marked on the original Bill of Lading and that the driver agrees with that temperature.
- v. When driver signs the Bill of Lading, he/she is confirming that he/she received the correct product and correct count at the proper temperature. Be sure they agree with the information on the Bill of Lading. Your company is responsible.
- vi. CARRIER certifies that any TRU equipment hired or furnished will be in compliance with the in-user requirements of California's TRU regulations.
