The Broker-Carrier Agreement or Carrier Agreement (in each case, the "Agreement") between Coyote Logistics, LLC, a Licensed Property Broker - USDOT # 2236410, and BRZ is amended by the verbal agreement between Jared Soderholm of Coyote Logistics, LLC hereafter referred to as BROKER, and Steve Tatum of BRZ hereafter referred to as CARRIER, dated 06/03/2024.

This confirmation is subject to the terms of the Agreement and this document constitutes an amendment thereto. If the CARRIER has not signed the Agreement, then the rate shown above is the agreed individually negotiated rate and no other rate shall apply including any carrier tariff rate or terms.

THIS LOAD SHALL NOT BE DOUBLE BROKERED. No additional charges not listed above may be added by the CARRIER. Any additional charges must appear on a revised confirmation sheet signed by the BROKER. CARRIER must include signed copy of the shipper's bill of lading and any other proof of delivery with invoice to BROKER. Rates, except as specifically designated above, are inclusive of any fuel surcharge. Drivers providing construction material delivery service must carry and abide by these instructions.

1. DELIVERY APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED:

All construction delivery traffic <u>will be required</u> to schedule with the Logistics Coordinator or Superintendent prior to shipping any material to the Wolf Run site. Please notify (2) days in advance of arrival either via phone or email.

2. DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS:

4. DELIVERY HOURS:

Site delivery times are from 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. CST (Final Appointment).

- By appointment only Monday thru Friday. (Time in and out may change due to Daylight Savings Time). Itis_ NOT a first come first serve.
- Calls will be answered from 7:00 a.m. till 4:00 p.m. CST Monday thru Friday only.
- A delivery date and time will be provided by Signal's Logistics Coordinator or Superintendent and given to your logistics personnel prior to delivery.

- All passengers must remain in their vehicle. Absolutely no pets are allowed outside of vehicle.
- Leave all loads secure and strapped until directed to remove them.
- NO REFER Trailers. Only Dry Vans, Containers and Flat Beds.
- Must have all proper paperwork/BOLs in hand not electronic copies and a prior scheduled appointment date and time.
- <u>Speed Limit</u> Drivers are to travel at a maximum speed of 10 mph while traveling on the job site or speed indicated on posted signs. Note: if you are causing dust please slow down and while passing the workers 5 mph.
- Trucks are prohibited from parking overnight onsite (please look for local truck stops in the area).
- <u>Cell phone operation</u> Absolutely no cell phone operation, verbal or text, is permitted while operating vehicles on site.
- <u>Seat belts</u> All drivers are required to wear seat belts while operating vehicles on site.
