TQL must approve all accessorial terms/charges in advance and in writing. Payment of detention is determined on a load-by-load basis. Unauthorized charges will not be paid. Detention payment does not begin for at least 3 hours unless otherwise agreed to in writing. To qualify for additional compensation, the Carrier MUST notify TQL at least 30 minutes before beginning detention time and when arriving-on-time/departing from all shippers/receivers (unless the shipper/receiver will notate check in/out times on the paperwork). TQL reserves the right to deny all additional charges unless communicated in advance writing and invoiced to TQL within 90 days of load completion. All demurrage, detention, and per diem charges must be communicated to TQL in writing within 30 days of load completion in order to validate and/or dispute with the steam ship line directly. TQL reserves the right to deny all demurrage, detention, and per diem charges communicated more than 30 days from invoice date. Carrier must file any disputes in regards to demurrage, detention, and per diem charges in writing with the billing party within 7 days from date of invoice.

Before Dispatch

- All drivers are required to have a valid US CDL - B1 drivers credentials will not be accepted.
- Carrier must complete and return the TQL Security form. Failure to return document will result in removal from the load.
- Driver must accept TQL's Carrier Dashboard, Macropoint, Project44, or FourKites Tracking prior to dispatching.
- Location Manager must be accepted on the driver's phone or ELD.

Load Requirements

- Exclusive use of the trailer is required, and load cannot be run as a partial. Breaking seal, loading other product on the truck or transloading for any reason is prohibited.
- Load must be run on a company-owned truck and trailer and load cannot be brokered to another company.
- If a team is booked, there must be 2 drivers in the truck when picking up and for the duration of the shipment.
- Must arrive to shipper with full tank of fuel, well-rested, and fresh on hours.
- Carrier must view loading/unloading process. Any shortages or damages must be reported immediately to TQL. If not allowed to view loading/unloading, driver must report immediately to TQL.

Equipment

- Trailer must be a dry van with swing doors.
- Trailer doors cannot have reversed bolts.
- Minimum of 3 load straps/bars are required.
- Trailer must have unique, identifiable markings (e.g. trailer number).
- Trailer must be clean, in sound physical condition, odor-free, dry and leak proof, and free from any contamination/infestation.
- Trailer must be 5 years or newer.
- Portable fire extinguisher should be equipped on the vehicle in good condition.

After Loading

- Must confirm trailer is locked and sealed before leaving shipper site.
- Must walk around trailer prior to departing shipper and report any suspicious markings on the trailer to TQL immediately.
- Upon leaving the shipper, must drive 250 miles prior to making first stop. (For loads less than 250 miles, must drive straight through, no stops).
- Driver must call TQL once loaded and delivered.

While OTR

- Driver must report suspicions of being followed to TQL immediately.
- Load cannot go to driver's home or be left unattended.
- Approved stops must include the following: fenced/gated/locked facility, be well-lit, and must have video surveillance or 24/7 security staffing on-site.
- Driver Must follow Samsung SCC Rules. Including when driver is stopping to rest, get fuel, etc.
- When stopped, trailer doors must be backed up against a wall or pole to prevent unauthorized access to cargo.
- After any stop, photo of intact seal must be sent before resuming transport.
- On time arrival and proper documentation with In and Out times clearly marked are required for detention to be honored
- BOL/POD must be sent to TQL within 3 hours of delivery.
