Rate Confirmation Agreement for TLD Logistics Services, Inc. (TLD Brokerage)

Rate and Accessorial

- Carrier must submit objections to the rate confirmation within 24 hours after receipt.
- Rate shown includes any applicable fuel surcharges.
- Other accessorial charges including pickup/delivery charges, loading/unloading charges, out of route, detention, storage, and/or all arbitrary charges must be approved in writing and signed by both parties.
- Unloading charges must be authorized by TLD Brokerage and will be reimbursed with a valid unloading receipt. TLD will provide an updated rate confirmation for authorized unloading charges.
- In order to qualify for detention, the carrier must notify TLD Brokerage of the detention delay within 2 hours of arrival or within 2 hours of scheduled appointment time. In addition, the driver must have in and out times written or stamped on the BOL/POD and signed by facility personnel. If the facility uses a control sheet, a copy of the control sheet with in and out times is acceptable. If the facility is FCFS, driver must arrive during confirmed loading/unloading hours. Late pick-ups or late deliveries are not eligible for detention charges.

Tracking Requirements and possible fines

- Early delivery is strictly prohibited without prior approval from TLD Brokerage. Early delivery may be subject to fines as imposed by the receiving location (early delivery can result in \$1000's of dollars in fines).
- Carrier will report missed pickup and missed delivery to TLD Brokerage prior pickup and delivery date/time. Without prior notification to TLD Brokerage the carrier will be subject to penalty charges of \$100 per day. Additional late delivery charges assessed by the consignee may also apply.
- MacroPoint Tracking: Carrier agrees to accept & driver will activate MacroPoint Tracking if requested.
 Failure to accept can result in a rate reduction in a predetermined amount as stated on the rate confirmation.

Refrigerated requirements

• All refrigerated loads must run on continuous cycle unless otherwise stated. Carrier will maintain reefer breakdown insurance during transportation of cargo.

Cargo Security and Transportation

- All trailer cargo security seals must be placed on the trailer with seal # noted on the BOL before leaving
 the shipping location or stop off. All security seals must remain intact. The security seal must be broken
 by consignee personnel and the POD signed "seal intact" at the consignee. In the event a security seal
 needs to be broken the carrier must get approval from TLD Brokerage. Loads delivered without the seals
 intact are subject to fines and potential claims. Seals protect the integrity of the load count. In the event
 law enforcement or DOT needs to break a security seal the carrier will advise TLD Brokerage immediately
 and get documentation from law enforcement or DOT.
- Driver is responsible for all load counts. If driver is not granted access to the loading dock call TLD Brokerage to notify immediately.
- Driver is responsible for ensuring shipment is properly secured before leaving shipper. If driver is not granted access to the loading dock call TLD Brokerage to notify immediately.
- Carrier acknowledges that they are solely responsible for compliance with all applicable HOS regulations, as well as all other FMCSA regulations.
- Any directions given to the carrier are for informational purposes only.



Contracted Carrier Requirements

- Carrier is hired by TLD Brokerage to provide exclusive use of equipment during transit of cargo. Unless TLD Logistics Services Inc provides written permission, exclusive use of equipment is required. If exclusive use is not provided fines and/or claims may apply.
- Carrier agrees this shipment will not be double or re-brokered. In the event of double or re-brokering of the agreed shipment the carrier forfeits the right to collect charges and agrees that TLD Brokerage may pay charges directly to the underlying carrier.
- Per our broker carrier agreement, if a scheduled auto insurance policy exist, the carrier agrees to ensure that the equipment being used for transport is listed on the carrier's scheduled auto policy. Agreement and Billing
- Carrier representative submission with acceptance and signature indicates approval of all rates and terms listed on rate confirmation.

All payments will be processed within **2 business days** of received date of the invoice received in the email inbox and all appropriate documentation for the load to be billed. All load paperwork, including the invoice, is due within 10 days of delivery to be eligible for quick pay. Please include "TLD Load Number on Rate confirmation" in the subject line of the email. All Quick Pays are to be emailed to BOTH <u>QuickPay@tldlogistics.com</u> and <u>sa_tkxv_cip@mcleodsoftware.com</u> Quick pays will receive a 3% deduction for processing. *For port deliveries, payment will be issued 2 days upon return of empty container* Per Diem and Chassis reimbursements are not eligible for quick pay.

Paperwork Requirements:

- 1. Carrier Invoice: One invoice per load.
- 2. TLD Rate Confirmation: Make sure final charges are reflected on rate confirmations to avoid short payments.
- 3. Signed and legible BOL with all pages scanned completely. No Partial Scans & TLD rate confirmations cannot be used for POD/BOL.
- 4. **Port Deliveries Only**: Interchange Tickets for Port both in and out
- 5. Lumper Receipts and other documents needed for accessorial reimbursement.
- 6. Additional documents may be required by TLD operations representative.
- 7. If load is "Truck Order not Used," an invoice is still required for payment.

Per Diem/Chassis Reimbursements:

Please ensure you have received final rate confirmation for all charges from your TLD Operations representative before submitting your invoice. Our Settlement Team is unable to authorize payment unless a revised rate confirmation with a new load number is received for additional charges, including per diem and chassis charges. The supporting invoices for these additional charges must be provided from the steamship liner and/or chassis provider.
