Terms and Conditions

The Broker-Carrier Agreement or Carrier Agreement (in each case, the "Agreement") between Coyote Logistics, LLC, a Licensed Property Broker - USDOT # 2236410, and BRZ is amended by the verbal agreement between Jared Soderholm of Coyote Logistics, LLC hereafter referred to as BROKER, and Phil of BRZ hereafter referred to as CARRIER, dated 03/21/2025.

This confirmation is subject to the terms of the Agreement and this document constitutes an amendment thereto. If the CARRIER has not signed the Agreement, then the rate shown above is the agreed individually negotiated rate and no other rate shall apply including any carrier tariff rate or terms.

THIS LOAD SHALL NOT BE DOUBLE BROKERED. No additional charges not listed above may be added by the CARRIER. Any additional charges must appear on a revised confirmation sheet signed by the BROKER. CARRIER must include signed copy of the shipper's bill of lading and any other proof of delivery with invoice to BROKER. Rates, except as specifically designated above, are inclusive of any fuel surcharge. CARRIER certifies that it is in compliance with all requirements of the California Air Resources Board (CARB) that are applicable to the scope of CARRIER's operations, including, but not limited to: Statewide Truck and Bus Regulations, Transport Refrigeration Unit (TRU) Regulations, Tractor-Trailer Greenhouse (GHG) Gas Regulations, and Drayage Truck Regulations. CARRIER also warrants that it is in compliance with any comparable requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and other states, where applicable. CARRIER shall be responsible for any fines imposed on BROKER and/or shipper resulting from noncompliance.

CARRIER hereby confirms that it maintains applicable and valid insurance without exclusions that would prevent coverage for the items listed above. CARRIER has at least \$100,000.00 in cargo insurance and \$1,000,000.00 in automobile liability coverage. CARRIER further confirms that in transporting the shipment described hereinabove, it will comply with all U.S. DOT and FDA regulations applicable to its operations while transporting said shipment, including, but not limited to drivers' hours of service, and the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA), if applicable. CARRIER agrees to the attached requirements from the shipper, if any.

ALL LOADS ARE SUBJECT TO ELECTRONIC TRACKING

By accepting this shipment, CARRIER agrees that it has obtained a written agreement from each driver transporting a shipment tendered by BROKER to CARRIER pursuant to the Agreement in which each driver provides all necessary consents to (i) receiving text messages and/or phone calls from or on behalf of BROKER and (ii) allowing BROKER or its vendor to track such driver's location while transporting such shipment. CARRIER shall comply with all applicable laws relating to the collection, use, storage, retention, disclosure, and disposal of any information CARRIER provides to BROKER, including information regarding the drivers transporting shipments. CARRIER shall indemnify, defend, and hold BROKER and its affiliates harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, losses, actions and expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising out of or in connection with CARRIER's breach of this Section. This Section shall survive the expiration or termination of the Agreement between BROKER and CARRIER.

OPERATING REQUIREMENTS

Chemours FC

Carrier, its employees, subcontractors, and agents must present two (2) forms of identification, one (1) of which must be a government issued photo identification. For ports and CHEMOURS site sites covered by the U.S. Maritime Transportation Security Act (MTSA), a Transportation Carrier Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) will be required.

CHEMOURS prohibits the use, possession, manufacture, dispensing, sale and distribution of alcohol, drugs, and other controlled substances on its CHEMOURS sites and on or in conjunction with equipment used to transport Cargo to or from a CHEMOURS site and that CHEMOURS prohibits the presence of individuals with such substances in their bodies in workplaces controlled by CHEMOURS unless the substances are being used for legitimate medical reasons under a physician's supervision; 2) entry onto CHEMOURS property constitutes consent to an inspection of the entering person, his or her vehicle, and personal effects when entering, while on, or upon exiting CHEMOURS property; and 3) any Carrier employee, agent, or subcontractor employee who is found to be in violation of the prohibition or who refuses to permit inspection may be removed and barred from performing further Services for CHEMOURS or from entering property controlled by CHEMOURS, and that such removal and bar are not subject to challenge.

Carrier shall permit Broker, CHEMOURS and/ or its authorized agent to audit Carrier's drug testing program to ensure compliance with applicable requirements.

Broker, CHEMOURS, and/or its authorized agent, shall have the right to periodically audit the safety and security practices of Carrier, its subcontractors, and agents with respect to records, equipment condition and operation, and employee training and performance.

CHEMTREC Reporting; Emergency Response

(1) Emergency Response Guides Carrier shall at all times maintain a copy (or reproduced portions of appropriate sections) of the current edition of the Department of Transportation's Emergency Response Guidebook in reasonable proximity of all Hazardous Materials as defined in 49 CFR Section 171.8 shipped under the terms of the Agreement while such material is in transit or while maintained in temporary storage by Carrier.

(2) Emergency Contact Information Carrier shall ensure that, for all Materials originating at CHEMOURS sites or transported, all Bills of Lading, Hazardous Waste Manifests, and shipping papers generated by Carrier clearly identify CHEMOURS as the knowledgeable person who should be contacted in the event of a release or other emergency involving the Materials. Carrier shall accomplish this by instituting and maintaining a process under which emergency responders will be provided with immediate and continuous access to CHEMOURS through the use of the CHEMTREC® Emergency Response System (800) 424-9300 (toll free).

In particular, Carrier shall notify CHEMTREC® in the event of:

- Release of any Material;
- Fire or explosion which impacts a CHEMOURS shipment;
- Damage to bulk equipment (empty or full) or equipment, or the content of either;

- Any damage to, or which threatens the integrity of, equipment transporting materials;
- An incident which because of its location or circumstances (including death), will have a high profile in the community.

(3) Shipment Descriptions Carrier shall ensure that all Bills of Lading, Hazardous Waste Manifests, and shipping papers generated by it or its agents for Hazardous and Non-Hazardous Materials originating at or designated to move to a CHEMOURS location pursuant to the terms of the Agreement include the full technical shipping description (see 49 CFR 172.602) for all Hazardous and Non-Hazardous Materials covered by the shipping papers and are in all other respects in full compliance with 49 CFR Parts 171, 172, and 173 before such Cargo and/or CHEMOURS Equipment is loaded, unloaded, reloaded, transported, or stored in transit.

CHEMOURS CORE VALUES

Safety, Health and Environment

Carrier shall abide by sound Safety, Health and Environment (SH&E) principles like those contained in the Responsible Care Program® (located at <http://responsiblecare.americanchemistry.com>) as published and periodically updated by the American Chemistry Council or an equivalent and relevant industry standard, and Carrier, if requested by Chemours, shall subscribe to an information verification company and answer Chemours questionnaire(s) accurately and completely to the satisfaction of Chemours. Carrier and Chemours shall communicate openly and work together on safety, health, and environment (including product stewardship) issues to achieve long term success for the businesses involved; provided, however, that either Party may request that any information that is disclosed be held confidential under reasonable confidential obligations. Meetings to review progress toward improvement will be held as required and may include safety, health, and environment (including product stewardship) assessments of Carrier's locations by Chemours.

Carrier shall:

- i. comply with all federal, state and local regulations and such other special safety provisions as may be provided by Chemours or Broker in writing to Carrier and its employees;
- ii. designate one person to be responsible for carrying out Carrier's obligations under this Section;
- iii. promptly report in writing to Broker cases of death, occupational disease and injury caused by work on the job;
- iv. promptly report to Broker all cases Carrier determines to be recordable on the OSHA 300 log or its equivalent and, upon request, provide Chemours with a copy of the OSHA 300 log and all supporting forms;
- v. maintain an educational program to assure the inclusion of safety instruction as a part of job assignment; and
- vi. arrange for emergency first-aid treatment of job-incurred injuries in accordance with requirements of its insurer for workers compensation insurance and applicable law.
