### **Terms and Conditions**

The Broker-Carrier Agreement or Carrier Agreement (in each case, the "Agreement") between Coyote Logistics, LLC, a Licensed Property Broker - USDOT # 2236410, and ROYAL3 INC is amended by the verbal agreement between Jared Soderholm of Coyote Logistics, LLC hereafter referred to as BROKER, and Leo D of ROYAL3 INC hereafter referred to as CARRIER, dated 04/16/2025.

This confirmation is subject to the terms of the Agreement and this document constitutes an amendment thereto. If the CARRIER has not signed the Agreement, then the rate shown above is the agreed individually negotiated rate and no other rate shall apply including any carrier tariff rate or terms.

THIS LOAD SHALL NOT BE DOUBLE BROKERED. No additional charges not listed above may be added by the CARRIER. Any additional charges must appear on a revised confirmation sheet signed by the BROKER. CARRIER must include signed copy of the shipper's bill of lading and any other proof of delivery with invoice to BROKER. Rates, except as specifically designated above, are inclusive of any fuel surcharge. CARRIER certifies that it is in compliance with all requirements of the California Air Resources Board (CARB) that are applicable to the scope of CARRIER's operations, including, but not limited to: Statewide Truck and Bus Regulations, Transport Refrigeration Unit (TRU) Regulations, Tractor-Trailer Greenhouse (GHG) Gas Regulations, and Drayage Truck Regulations. CARRIER also warrants that it is in compliance with any comparable requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and other states, where applicable. CARRIER shall be responsible for any fines imposed on BROKER and/or shipper resulting from noncompliance.

CARRIER hereby confirms that it maintains applicable and valid insurance without exclusions that would prevent coverage for the items listed above. CARRIER has at least \$100,000.00 in cargo insurance and \$1,000,000.00 in automobile liability coverage. CARRIER further confirms that in transporting the shipment described hereinabove, it will comply with all U.S. DOT and FDA regulations applicable to its operations while transporting said shipment, including, but not limited to drivers' hours of service, and the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA), if applicable. CARRIER agrees to the attached requirements from the shipper, if any.

#### ALL LOADS ARE SUBJECT TO ELECTRONIC TRACKING

By accepting this shipment, CARRIER agrees that it has obtained a written agreement from each driver transporting a shipment tendered by BROKER to CARRIER pursuant to the Agreement in which each driver provides all necessary consents to (i) receiving text messages and/or phone calls from or on behalf of BROKER and (ii) allowing BROKER or its vendor to track such driver's location while transporting such shipment. CARRIER shall comply with all applicable laws relating to the collection, use, storage, retention, disclosure, and disposal of any information CARRIER provides to BROKER, including information regarding the drivers transporting shipments. CARRIER shall indemnify, defend, and hold BROKER and its affiliates harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, losses, actions and expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising out of or in connection with CARRIER's breach of this Section. This Section shall survive the expiration or termination of the Agreement between BROKER and CARRIER.

### Operating Parameters Johns Manville Corporation ("JM")

Carrier must adhere to the following requirements of Johns Manville:

<u>Incident Notification</u>: Carrier will notify Broker within two (2) business hours and must not exceed twenty-four (24) clock hours of any incident, accident, and/or loss/theft of JM's goods while in the Carrier's possession. JM will determine from Carrier's description of damages whether Carrier shall complete final destination delivery or return the goods to a designated JM site.

When JM or consignee has reason to believe that its goods may have experienced internal damage even though there is no external evidence of rough handling or other damage, JM may require the driver to remain while the conveyance is unloaded or packages are opened and record the facts revealed in the course of such joint inspection in the delivery receipt or separate inspection report, said receipt or report to be signed by the driver.

<u>Damaged Shipment Inspection</u>: Inspection will be made by the Carrier within five (5) normal workdays after receipt of request from JM/consignee. Inspection by Carrier will include examination of the damaged merchandise the shipping container and any other action necessary to establish that a loss has occurred. Inspection will be limited to factual report. The original of the report will be given the consignee for claim support. Any inspection report issued must be incorporated in the claim file.

### **CARRIER'S ACCESS TO JM'S FACILITIES**

To the extent deemed necessary by JM for performance of the Services, JM may permit Carrier access to JM's facilities during normal hours of operation, or if pre-scheduled, outside of normal hours of operation. Carrier's personnel are to remain in designated areas, escorted by JM employees, or may be unescorted if following instructions given by a JM employee. JM may require the Carrier's personnel to wear visible JM-issued identification badge(s). JM, at its sole discretion, may deny access to a Carrier's employee, subcontractor, or agent.

<u>Review of Drug Test and Criminal Background Check Materials</u>: To the extent permitted by law, Carrier shall maintain and have readily available for inspection and/or audit by Broker/JM all policies pertaining to drug tests and background checks of all Personnel. In keeping with its obligations under the U.S. Drug Free Workplace Act or other governmental agency requirements, JM is committed to providing a safe work environment for its employees. As part of this effort, the Carrier attests that its drug testing program is in compliance with the applicable U.S. Government Regulations and that all Carrier's personnel, subcontractors, or providers that are involved with storing or transporting JM product have completed all required drug tests.

<u>Truckers Against Trafficking (TAT)</u>: JM supports the efforts of Truckers Against Trafficking (TAT) and expects all Carriers to comply with the principles of organizations such as TAT, with respect to resisting forced labor, prostitution or other means of coercion throughout the world.

<u>U.S. EPA SmartWay Program</u>: JM supports the efforts of the U.S. EPA SmartWay Program (SmartWay) and expects all Carriers to be registered with the SmartWay program and comply with the principles of this program. JM expects Carriers to report their SmartWay based statistics to JM on an annual basis per the reporting guidelines as defined by the SmartWay program.

<u>Hazardous Materials</u>: For all hazardous materials, as defined in the US 49 C.F.R. § 171.8, ("Hazardous Materials") tendered to Carrier, Carrier, its subcontractors, and its agents shall perform services in compliance with all applicable governmental regulations (federal, state, and local) concerning Hazardous Materials and environmental protection, industry best practices, and the loading, unloading, storage, handling, and transportation requirements set forth in the applicable SDS or other instructions from Broker/JM. Carrier shall immediately notify Broker/JM of any alleged or self-assessed violation of applicable hazardous materials regulations that occurred in connection with a load containing JM's Hazardous Materials or any accident, puncture and/or spillage (whether reaching outside a trailer or not) involving JM's Hazardous Materials.

<u>Emergency Response</u>: Carrier shall have documented emergency response plans addressing Hazardous Materials shipments under this Agreement. Carrier will provide documentation when requested by Broker/JM within one (1) business day of a written request.

<u>Security:</u> Carrier certifies that it is compliant with 49 C.F.R. part 172, subpart I (Safety and Security Plans) and will maintain and follow documented security plans to ensure the secure shipment of Hazardous Materials under this Agreement.

<u>Releases:</u> Carrier shall immediately notify Broker/JM of any incident or release involving Hazardous Materials (JM Emergency phone number is located on the JM Bill of Lading) tendered to it and immediately contain and collect any release consistent with its emergency response plan and Broker/JM's instructions. Carrier will comply with all directions and instructions of Broker/JM concerning a release, to the extent they do not conflict with those of a governmental authority. If Hazardous Materials tendered to Carrier are involved in an incident for which foreign, federal, state, provincial, or local law or regulation requires a report, Carrier shall make such report and will copy Broker/JM. For all incidents and releases arising from the acts or omissions of Carrier or its agents or subcontractors and involving Hazardous Materials tendered hereunder, Carrier will defend, indemnify, and hold JM harmless against any and all costs, including reporting costs, response costs, and clean-up costs, losses, liabilities, claims, fines, penalties, expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees), and fees arising out of the release.

<u>Verifying Piece Count</u>: Carrier will receive all shipments arranged on behalf of JM and reconcile pieces and weight against the original bill of lading at the time of receipt and reconcile physical box numbers against documentation (box list/packing list). Carrier shall notify Broker/JM immediately regarding any weight discrepancies.

<u>Seal Verification</u>: If Carrier is transporting a full truckload and JM has affixed a security seal, at any point during transit that the seal has been broken, Carrier will Broker/JM within one (1) hour of noticing the broken seal. Carrier is also required to verify 1) that the seal matches the number on the paperwork, 2) at origin has been affixed correctly and 3) at destination to verify the seal is still intact.

<u>Carrier Equipment</u>: Carrier shall provide and maintain in accordance with applicable laws and industry practice, at its own cost and expense, all motor vehicle equipment necessary or required for performance of the services hereunder, including without limitation trucks, tractors, and trailers. Carrier shall pay all expenses related, in any way, to the use and operation of the equipment.

<u>Carrier Equipment Cleanliness</u>: Carrier shall only provide and use equipment that is clean, in good operating condition, repair and appearance, and properly configured to safely load, transport, and unload shipments tendered by Broker/JM. Carrier shall ensure that no trailer or other vehicle that will transport goods under this Agreement has been used to transport refuse, garbage, trash or solid or liquid waste of any kind whatsoever, whether hazardous or non-hazardous. JM may inspect and reject any equipment provided by Carrier that fails to meet the and Carrier shall promptly provide replacement equipment and bear the costs and expenses relating to the same. Trailers must be clean, and have the necessary equipment (E.g. tarps, lift gates, straps, hand trucks, etc.) to ensure efficient and damage-free transport and delivery.

<u>Drivers:</u> Carrier shall ensure that its drivers are properly trained and licensed in accordance with applicable laws and are qualified and competent to operate the motor vehicles used to transport JM's shipments. Carrier shall, and shall ensure that its employees, agents, and subcontractors, comply with all applicable safety laws and any rules, policies, and procedures in effect at JM's or a consignee's facility made known to Carrier.

<u>Driver Identification</u>: Carrier's driver must carry identification clearly identifying the driver as Carrier's employee, agent, or contractor. This identification must be presented JM at pick up when requested.

<u>Trailer Location</u>: Carrier agrees to ensure that each trailer furnished for the Services is equipped with technology capable of transmitting all Content requested by the Vendor to track such trailer; provided, however, that if no such trailer is available, Carrier may comply with the requirements herein by furnishing a tractor with adequate GPS technology. If Carrier is unable to comply with this paragraph by furnishing a tractor or trailer with adequate technology, Carrier, with prior consent of JM, may comply with this paragraph by ensuring the driver of the shipment is furnished with a GPS-enabled cellular telephone capable of transmitting all required Content, and that the driver takes any other steps necessary for Carrier to comply with the requirements herein.

<u>Inbound to Origin Location</u>: Prior to arriving at the pick-up location for any shipment, Carrier must provide the Vendor with all required content relating to the specific shipment, including without limitation identifying information for the tractor, trailer, and/or cellular telephone that shall be used to transmit required Content. If such required information changes during the duration of any shipment, Carrier must provide the Vendor with updated information as soon as practicable, but in no event later than fifteen (15) minutes after information for a shipment becomes outdated.

<u>Distracted Driving</u>: Carrier expressly acknowledges that operating any vehicle while using a hand- held mobile telephone or other electronic device is dangerous and might be against the law. Nothing in the requirements herein shall be construed as requiring Carrier or any driver to operate such devices while operating any vehicle, including without limitation while such vehicle is temporarily stationary because of traffic, a traffic control device, or other momentary delays during transit. Carrier shall be solely responsible for the use by any driver of a handheld mobile telephone or other electronic device, and shall ensure that any use of such devices by Carrier and its drivers complies with all state and federal laws and regulations, including without limitation requirements set forth in 49 C.F.R. Sections 392.80 and 392.82

#### PENALTIES

<u>Carrier Tender Accepted then Reject on No Show</u>: Upon acceptance by the carrier of a load tender for shipment and then subsequently failing to provide equipment to meet the scheduled ship and delivery dates a fee may be levied against this carrier in the amount of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars, per occurrence, unless carrier advises Broker more than thirty-six (36) hours in advance of shipment that they cannot perform.
