Carrier Requirements:

- Driver must accept and maintain TQL's Carrier Dashboard/Macropoint/Project44 Tracking for the duration of the shipment.
- In the event of a breakdown, accident, delay in transit or any OTR incident that jeopardizes on time delivery may request to repower your trailer to help mitigate potential claims or consequential damages.
- Exclusive use of the trailer is required, and the load cannot be run as a partial.
- Trailer must be locked and sealed prior to leaving the shipper, If a seal is not placed on the back of the truck at the time of loading TQL will need to be notified prior to leaving the shipper.
- Driver(s) must arrive at the shipper with a full tank of fuel, well rested, and fresh on hours.
- Driver(s) must drive 250 miles after picking up. If load is less than 250 miles the driver(s) must drive straight through to the receiver after picking up.
- IF being instructed by anyone other than TQL to change course, redeliver to new addresses, stop at undisclosed locations you must contact TQL immediately.
- Load cannot go to the driver's home or be left unattended.
- TQL must be notified any time a stop is made.
- Driver(s) must back up against a wall or pole to ensure the doors cannot be opened any time a stop is to be made. For Teams, one driver must maintain line of sight with the trailer doors at all times.
- If scheduled live delivery appointment is missed, rescheduled appointment will be a drop delivery.

Reefer Requirements:

- Trailers must be food grade: clean, dry, odor free, no holes, leaks, protrusions, or debris. Trailer must have no personal items and have no sign of mold, pests, or infestation.
- Reefer units must be in sound physical condition – with working air chute and proper trailer door seals.
- All reefer units must be 10 years or newer with the ability to obtain a reefer download upon request.
- Reefer doors must be closed immediately after loading process has been completed.
- All instances of breakdown or temperature fluctuation must be reported to TQL immediately upon occurrence.



Detention/Layover Requirements (For All Picks and Drops):

- Tracking must be accepted and maintained for the duration of the load. No detention/layover will be approved for un-tracked loads.

- FCFS 4 hour free then \$25/hour capping at layover.
- Drop Appointments are 72 hours free and then \$150 per day afterward.
- Layover is \$150 after 24 hours.
- TONU is \$150.

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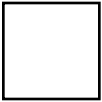

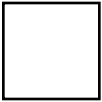

- Reefer units must be in sound physical condition - with working air chute and proper trailer door seals.
- All reefer units must be 10 years or newer with the ability to obtain a reefer download upon request.
- Reefer doors must be closed immediately after loading process has been completed.
- All instances of breakdown or temperature fluctuation must be reported to TQL immediately upon occurrence.

Detention/Layover Requirements (For All Picks and Drops):

- Tracking must be accepted and maintained for the duration of the load. No detention/layover will be approved for un-tracked loads.
- Carrier must be checked in/on time for their appointment. If given an appointment, FCFS, or arrival window, the driver must arrive within the given window.
- Carrier must notify TQL 30 minutes before detention time begins by call, text, or email.
- All pages of the BOL/POD must be emailed to TeamTarget@tql.com within 24-48 hours of delivery to be reviewed for detention.
- BOL/POD must have printed, stamped, or handwritten check in and check out times.
- Handwritten times should be signed by the facility as well as matching TQLs tracking to be accepted.

Detention Payment Schedule:

- APPT 3 Hours free then \$25/hour capping at layover.
- FCFS 4 hour free then \$25/hour capping at layover.
- Drop Appointments are 72 hours free and then \$150 per day afterward.
- Layover is \$150 after 24 hours.
- TONU is \$150.

Carrier Site Safety Requirements:

- Transport trailer to designated yard location. Pull past empty spot and back into location. NEVER blind side back in.
- Immediately notify TQL upon the occurrence or observation of a: safety incident, unsafe yard condition, trailer assignment yard location change, or tandem sliding concern.
- Driver(s) must behave respectfully and not use inappropriate language, threats, or physically harm and staffers or others while on shipper or receiver property.



- No cutting through parking spots and lanes.
- Tandems must be properly slid back on all drop trailers prior to leaving the yard.
- Ensure that all landing gear is on the designated concrete slab to eliminate trailer movement/shifting while staged in yard slot.
- 4-way flashers must be always on.
- No pedestrian traffic in the yard. Only use designated parking and walk paths.
- Safety vests must always be worn by ANY individuals while on the yard. Vests must have reflective striping, & high visibility fabric and color.
- Yard speed limit of 15 MPH is to be adhered to by all vehicles operating on the yard at all times.

Target Distribution Center Safety and Security/Yard Policies

Security & Safety Non-Negotiables:

- Please watch for all other traffic and pedestrians while driving on the yard.
- **ALWAYS** wear your reflective safety vest/shirt when outside of your cab.
- **NEVER** pull a trailer from a dock door. Our yard service provider will pull the trailer from the door and deliver to the empty row.
- Speed limit is **15 MPH**
- Do **NOT** walk in the yard among the trailers. If you exit your tractor, you must have on a reflective safety vest.
- You may only be on the yard to hook and unhook to/from a trailer, complete a trailer inspection, and go into the packet office to give/receive paperwork.
- Do **NOT** cut through staging lanes or parking areas.
- In adherence with CTPAT guidelines, Security may ask to check your photo ID upon entry.
- Target prohibits weapons on company property in accordance with local, state and federal law.

Safety/Security Policies:

- Reflective Safety Vests/Shirts MUST be worn when outside of your cab.
- All drivers who enter the RDC building must wear a driver badge at all times.
- Closed toed and heel covering shoes are required.
- While in the DC warehouse, you must be accompanied by a DC team member to and from your trailer. You may stay with your trailer during unload process, but must stay in the Driver's Lounge during breaks. Driver assisted unload is up to the discretion of the operations manager and only for non-ART doors.
- All vehicles are subject to interior and exterior search by Security upon entry and exit of the facility. **Do not seal your trailer before exiting the property.** All drivers are required to check-out with Security prior to departure. If empty please leave your doors open for security.
- Trailer legs must be lowered only on the concrete strips – not on the black top.
- Smoking is limited to designated areas only – no smokeless tobacco is allowed.
- Persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- **NO** pets outside of your vehicle.
- **NO** cell phone usage including Bluetooth devices while operating vehicles.

Live Unload Policies for RDC:

- Please slide TANDEM back to the rear/tail of the trailer
- Drivers **MUST** drop the trailer in the location specified by Security and **MUST unhook** from the trailer
- Row / staging overview:
 - Driver to drop off in low C row numbers as assigned below.
 - Drivers to pick up in high C row – Packet Office will let the driver know the location when they return.

- Bring paperwork to the packet office clericals for further instructions.
- Drivers MUST leave the property during unload.
- You will be notified by text or phone call when your trailer is complete.

- Please leave premises with-in 30 minutes after your unload is complete.
- Tractor idling must comply with Target's posted policy.
- Drivers are not permitted to layover/sleep on Target property.




