\*\*\* Trailers must be able to scale 44,000. Reefers must be off and dry with no smells or juices. Dry vans must be food grade. Detention at shipper/receiver paid if on time for appt. if late for appt, you will be worked in and no Detention paid. Please mark check in and check out times on BOL for detention to be processed. Detention requests must be sent in within 12 hours of loading/unloading with proof of check in and out times to be processed.Must consistently track for detention approval

# **UNFI Deliveries (Detention Process):**

    - 2 hours (palletized/roll off loads) from scheduled appointment/arrival time.

- Driver must obtain a receiver stamp showing driver arrival of no later than 15 min from UNFI scheduled appointment.
  - Driver must be backed into an assigned door within 20 minutes of arrival (unless delayed due to dock congestion)
- Detention accrual will stop when Capstone Logistics notifies carrier of payment amount due.
